Think for Actions, a Canadian based organization advocating acceptance and cultural integration, has condemned the violent attacks carried out at the Islamic Cultural Centre of Quebec, which has claimed the lives of six people.

Dr. Mukarram Ali Zaidi, chairman of Think for Actions, issued the following statement regarding the recent Quebec City Mosque shooting: “We condemn the violence, loss of life, fear among the community and the division this thoughtless act has caused. This is a shock to us all living in Canada. It is a terrible time in our history that we must witness such a test to our values. We will join together as one nation and one people and with time we will defeat fear and embrace diversity.”

Think for Actions aims to dispel myths about Islam and bridge the gap of miscommunication between North American Muslims and the public.
