Think for Actions is concerned about border screening on religious values

“An RCMP guide for screening asylum seekers includes several questions that appear to target Muslims. When asked about the questionnaire, a spokesperson for Public Safety Minister Ralph Goodale told the Star the RCMP has suspended its use”, The Star.

“RCMP officers have been screening Muslim refugee claimants entering from the U.S. at Quebec’s Roxham Rd. crossing, asking how they feel about women who do not wear the hijab, how many times they pray, and their opinion about the Taliban and the Islamic State, a questionnaire obtained by the Star shows”, The Star.

The Facts are:

- Dr. Muhammad Tahir-ul-Qadri published a 475-page Fatwa denouncing terrorism and suicide bombing.
- As its clear from the Quran, “Whoever kills an innocent life it is as if he has killed all of humanity...” (Surat Al-Maidah 5:32).
- Canadian council of Imams declaration states, “The sanctity of human life overrides the sanctity of religious laws. Islamic rulings do not – and should not – contradict natural laws. Islam is a religion that promotes peace, justice, equality, dignity, and freedom for all human beings”.
- Muslims Imams and leadership have clear messages, after the London attack in June this year 500 imams condemn terrorists and refuse to perform funeral prayer for ‘vile murderers’, this was to outline renewed efforts to combat extremism. (Independent, UK. Wednesday 7 June 2017)
- Dr. Robert Pape is an American political scientist from the University of Chicago known for his work on international security affairs, and especially on the rationale of suicide terrorism. One of his most profound studies examined 315 cases of terrorism from 1980 – 2005. Below was his conclusion: “The data show that there is little connection between suicide terrorism and Islamic fundamentalism, or any one of the world’s religions. ... Rather, what nearly all suicide terrorist attacks have in common is a specific secular and strategic goal: to compel modern democracies to withdraw military forces from territory that the terrorists consider to be their homeland”

Dr. Mukarram Zaidi said, “its concerning to know that we are religiously profiling refugees and public would like to know which other agencies are religiously profiling Canadians and what is the scientific evidence of theses questions that can identify a potential threat or patter, we look forward to work with the government to ensure rights of all Canadian’s are protected and they are safe”.
